1. Getting started:

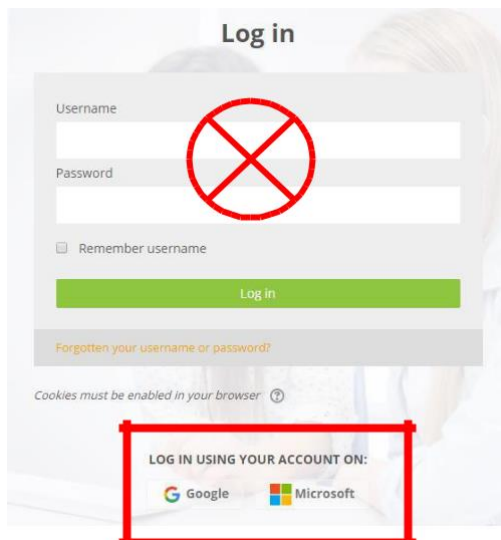
Please visit www.onlinesafetyalliance.org and select the green 'Certificate Log In' button on the home page:



2. Logging in

Please select the option to log in using a Microsoft or Google account. Make sure you use the Microsoft / Google buttons at the bottom; don't enter details into the username and password boxes.

If you don't have a Microsoft or Google account, please click Google and you will be given the option to make an account.
