

Entry requirements needed for Sixth Form, College and Apprenticeships

Sixth Form

Alcester Grammar School - AGS

 Minimum entry requirements are at least grade 4 in Maths & English Language, and a minimum of grade 5 in 4 other subjects.

Stratford-upon-Avon High School

 Minimum entry requirements are 5 GCSEs at level 4-9 including English Language and Maths (GCSE equivalent qualifications will be considered on a case by case basis.

Prince Henry's High School

- Minimum entry requirement of 30 points across their best 6 GCSEs.
- Maths & English GCSE are required at a grade 4.
- Note that some subjects have a minimum grade requirements.

Chipping Campden School

- Minimum entry requirements are 5 GCSEs at grade 4-9 including English Language & Maths.
- Note that some subjects require or prefer grade 6 at GCSE.

St Augustine's Catholic High School

 Minimum of 5 level 2 qualifications passes. These must comprise of GCSE 5-9 in English Language, English Literature and Maths, and merit levels in BTEC subjects.

King Edwards VI – KES

- Minimum entry requirement of 64 points from their best 8 GCSE results.
- To be able to take a particular subject at A Level, students are expected to achieve grade 7 at GCSE in that subject.

Stratford Girls Grammar School

- Minimum entry requirement of 54 points from their best 8 GCSE results.
- Maths & English Language GCSE are required at grade 6 or above.

• To be able to take a particular subject at A Level, students are expected to achieve at least a grade 7 at GCSE in that subject (or equivalent of).

College (campus)

- Stratford-Upon-Avon SUAC: Stratford/Solihull
- Heart of Worcestershire HOW: Redditch/Bromsgrove/Worcester
- Warwickshire College Group WCG: **Evesham/Moreton Morrell/Pershore**
- Hartpury: Leamington/Warwick/Rugby

Minimum entry guidelines

Vocational level 3: 4 x GCSE grades 9-4 including English & Maths or achievement at level 2.

Vocational level 2: 4 x GCSE grades 3 or higher including English & Maths. And/or prior achievement at Level 1.

Vocational level 1 & Entry level: No formal qualifications.

<u>Apprenticeships</u> (Equivalent Educational Level)

- Intermediate Level 2: 5 GCSE passes at grade 9-4
- Advanced Level 3: 2 A Level passes/Level 3 diploma
- Higher Level 4,5,6&7: Foundation degree & above
- Degree Level 6&7: bachelor's or master's degree
