Easter Bingo Update-Friday 8th March

- A. Tickets So far, we have sold 24 full books and 4 single £248.
- B. Bingo prizes Thanks to Clare for working with Tesco to arrange the eggs. These have been collected and are stored at Clare's until we need them for prize packing. Tesco donated 2 of the larger eggs so the total cost to us was £125. £14.55 less than last year. The Friends collected £200 for our participation in the Santa Route. Rachel proposed that £100 of this be donated to the studio fund. This was seconded my Paula and agreed by those present in the meeting.

Sabrina thought it might be a nice idea to also do a buy a brick for a certain donation. Then we engrave their name on the brick. She suggested £50. We will consider this further.

The Round Table has said to contact them with any volunteering needs we may have when we need to empty the unit as they may be able to assist.

Charlie McKenzie, Assistant Headteacher will be liasing with Mr Badbam about a Rock Academy gig with special guests to raise funds for the studio fund. She is also waiting to hear about a grand from a bid she has put in.
