Purpose

Terms of Reference

Quality of Education:

- To advise and keep under review and report on a strategy which will enable the full governing body to understand how the whole school is improving against the OFSTED framework, namely Quality of Teaching, Learning & Assessment and Outcomes for Pupils.
- To advise on the content, monitor and report progress on aspects of the School Development Plan/Academy Improvement Plan relating to quality of learning
- To carry out the governing body's responsibilities in relation to target setting, progress and attainment, including monitoring student progress and attainment against set targets.
- To ensure the academy delivers a broad and balanced curriculum as outlined by the DfE in response to the needs of all learners.
- To carry out the Governors' responsibilities in relation to students with additional needs; to include SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) and provision for most able students.



Human Resources:

- To prepare and keep under review the HR aspects of the School Improvement Plan including identifying and agreeing key areas, as agreed with the Headteacher
- To review and monitor the staffing structure and, where appropriate, work with the Headteacher, Chair of Governors and the Committee Chairs to agree any proposed changes to the structure.
- Keep under review and advise on the implementation of any agreed structural changes, staff development activity including CPD for all teaching staff, appraisal cycle including any emerging performance issues which may or may lead to the application of the Capability policy
- Monitor application of the teacher's Pay Policy, as a result of outcomes from Appraisal. Liaise with Chair of Finance Committee and advise Governing Body on financial impact.
