Please find this week's updates for Year 11 specifically. Thanks to Mr Cooke for putting together the information for you last week. I am also grateful to many of you who found time to help get students to Easter holiday sessions, thank you for this.

Alternative Timetable

I have attached a copy of the Alternative Timetable for you as parents. This has been discussed now for many weeks both via letters and also specifically with the students in an assembly. The timetable shows how we manage key sessions of revision before GCSE exams for the students. Although it may appear complicated, on Monday, students will receive their own hard copy and will sit and highlight their personal pathway through the exam season.
